New Business: Mr. Cecil Smith and Ms. Diane Forrester from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet were introduced and invited to discuss the Brannon Road Improvement Project. The Highway fund for funding the project has passed. As it is planned now, the project will be 3 lanes from Harrodsburg Road to Nicholasville Road; two lanes for traffic and one turning lane. A 10 ft. multi-use path will run down the northside of the road and a 5 ft. sidewalk will run on the southside. A light will be installed at the Clays Mill intersection and an overpass will be built over the railroad crossing.

It is imperative that Brannon Road property owners contact the Transportation Cabinet to discuss the project and the effect on their property.
